What is It?

PIV is a browser application that allows you to view real-time information regarding your child's classes, grades or attendance whenever you want. All you need is a student ID number and a password.

How do you take advantage of these services?

Obtain an application form from either the Main Office, or the Guidance Department. The parent/guardian can return it to the school in person with a picture ID or you can have the form notarized and return it by mail, your student, or in person to the school. For the PIV, the parent can stop by the Guidance Department in person to obtain the password. All forms will be verified against the school records and the student's Emergency Notification Card, which must be on file.

When accessing the PIV through the link at <http://www.polk-fl.net>, you will need your child's 6-digit student ID number and the password provided to you from the school.
