Car Rider Line—Morning



Please remember the following when you are dropping your child off in the morning:

- Please pull all the way forward to keep the line moving. Your child will be able to walk to his/her classroom from any point along the sidewalk.
- If your child's classroom is located in a portable, he/she will wait for his/her teacher along the main building. Please do not drop him/her off at the portables.
- Do not get out of your car to let your child out or release your child on the driver's side of the car. It is not safe!
- Please do not park in the main parking lot and run your child across the traffic.

PLEASE NOTE: Our #1 goal is to ensure the safety of all students. Please stay in the car rider line and drop your child at the curb. We will make sure that your child gets to class.

Please understand why we are asking for parents not to walk children to class.

- Safety of students—it increases the number of "strangers" on campus.
- Safety of students and adults—our parking is limited. You must cross the parking lot. Cars are often not paying attention to where they are going. We don't want anyone hurt.
- Safety of students—too much traffic in the hallways is not safe for anyone.

IMPORTANT: If you are coming to the office or paying lunch money, please park in the lot by the P.E. field and check in at the office before accessing the campus.

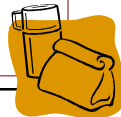
Grades online ...
